Reminder: If you need a signature, official transcript, or form filled out for a scholarship application, please complete the entire application, place it in a stamped, addressed envelope, and hand deliver to Mr. Ludwig in the College Office 7E2 at least FIVE DAYS before the application is due. The application then will be completed and mailed by the College Office (BRANCH LOCATED IN 7E2).

Gordon A. Rich Memorial Foundation Scholarship: \$50,000 for four years (\$12,500/yr): Parents and/or legal guardians of the students applying must have, or had, a career in the financial services industry. Students must demonstrate financial need. Students must have a GPA of 91.7 Applications to be found at www.gordonrich.org
