**Martin V. Alonzo Family Foundation Scholarships:** Amount varies/renewable for four years. Only for Brooklyn Tech seniors who intend to study at Baruch College. Financial need and strong academics are needed. If you are interested, please see Mr. Ludwig in 7E2.

**Robert G. Porter Scholars Program (AFT):** Four (4) \$8,000 scholarships for seniors who are dependents of AFT members who are on the active rolls for at least one year. The senior should be pursuing a career in labor, education, health care or government service. **Kassenbrock Brothers Memorial Scholarships of the Bay Ridge Community Council:**

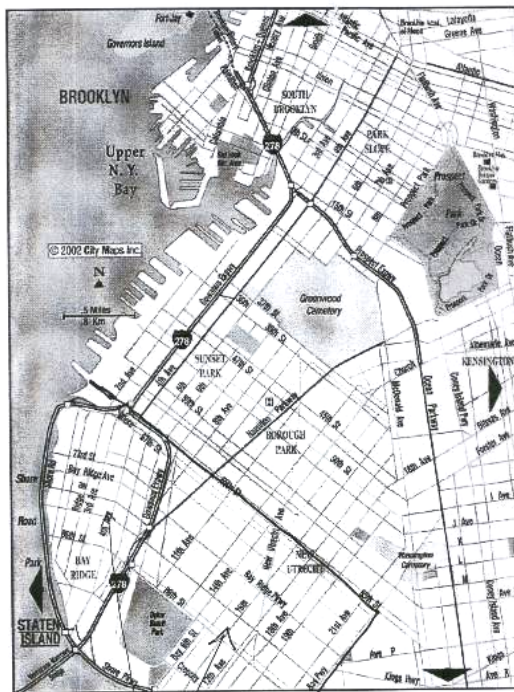
