Rock and Roll Hall of Fame Foundation: \$5,000 (5) scholarship to seniors who are not majoring in music. Applicants must submit an essay on rock and roll music's impact upon their lives, its specific inspirational aspects, and the ways in which its importance will be reflected in their personal and professional life choices. Online application at <http://schools.nyc.gov/offices/teachlearn/arts/competitions.html> Deadline **May 1**.

Brooklyn Girl Friends Friendship Fund Scholarship: \$1,000 stipends. For women, based upon academic achievement, service to school and community, commendable future goals, and financial need. Applications from 7E2. Deadline: **April 10**.

Brooklyn Alumnae Chapter of Delta Sigma Theta Sorority Scholarships: \$1,000-\$2,000 (renewable). Eligibility: Residents of Brooklyn. African-American female seniors. Also, **Shirley Chisholm Scholarship** for a Brooklyn resident enrolled at Brooklyn college with a major in Women Studies or Political Science. **Beverly Vance Memorial Scholarship** for student seeking a four year degree majoring in Communications, Speech, Drama, or related field. Application forms in 7E2. Deadline: **April 15**.

New York State Youth Leadership Council Awards: \$500 (10 awards). Two fellowships. Eligibility: Must desire to become engaged with the immigrant community, have a 2.5 GPA (77), and if awarded must attend a mandatory leadership development curriculum. Must attend awards ceremony on the evening of June 5 or June 6. Applications from 7E2. Deadline: **May 1**.

Association of Dominican-American Supervisors and Administrators (ADASA): \$500 (4) Eligibility: Dominican descent, graduating senior who has been accepted to a college or university. Applications from 7E2. Deadline: **April 3**.

Club Primevere Annual Scholarship: \$500-\$1000 one-time award (2). For Haitian American students showing scholastic aptitude, leadership and service. Must have definable career goals. Requires a 500 word essay on topic: "Once you have achieved your goal as a professional, how would you give back to your community?" If you are interested in being nominated for this award, please see Mr. Ludwig in 7E2 as soon as possible, but in no case later than **April 21**.
