Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, East Kings County Book Scholarship for College Bound High School

Seniors: \$1,500. Applicant must be minority high school senior (African-American, Native American, Asian, Hispanic, or Other), 80 GPA and live in Greenpoint-Williamsburg, Bushwick, Highland Park, Cypress Hills, East NY, New Lots, Spring Creek, Starrett City, Gravesend, Homecrest, Coney Island, Sheepshead Bay, Ocean Hill, Brownsville, or Canarsie. Applications available in 7E2. Official Deadline: **May 9, however extensions will be granted if you email an extension request to scholarship@ekcdst.org**

Dedalus Foundation Scholarships: \$1,500 (7) for graduating seniors who intend to further their studies in fine arts or art history. Three scholarships are awarded in art history and four in the fine arts portfolio category. Portfolios must be delivered by May 12. Details in 7E2. Art History scholarships require a 3-5 page essay, a 200 word statement describing aspiration and future plans, two letters of recommendation and an application form obtainable in 7E2. Again, deadline: **May 12.**

Requires 85GPA and 1,800 on SATs. Essay also required. Scholarship can be used at any college or university. Application for in 7E2. Deadline: **May 29th.**
