Gates Millennium Scholarship Program: Scholarships for Asian Americans, African Americans, Native Americans, Hispanic Americans. Scholarships extend to graduate study for certain fields. Must have financial need. Although one must be nominated, the Nominee is allowed to submit his/her application and then seek a Nominator, as well as a Recommender. SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CHILDREN OF A DECEASED OR DISABLED VETERANS

Regents Award for the Child of a Veteran: For child of deceased veteran, 40% disabled vet, or POW or MIA in specified conflicts. \$450/yr for up to five years. Also, **Military Service Recognition Scholarship:** For child of a deceased veteran who died in combat operations or in training for combat in designated regions.
