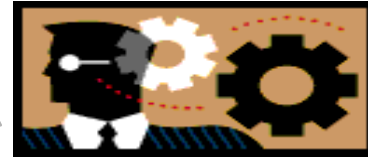

## Scholarship News #11



**Dedalus Foundation Scholarships:** \$1,500 (7) for graduating seniors who intend to further their studies in fine arts or art history. Three scholarships are awarded in art history and four in the fine arts portfolio category. Portfolios must be delivered by May 12. Details in 7E2. Art History scholarships require a 3-5 page essay, a 200 word statement describing aspiration and future plans, two letters of recommendation and an application form. **Deadline: May 11**

**Mark Rothko Scholarship in Memory of Gustave Harrow:** \$1,000(6). For the arts. **Dr. Calvin Martin Memorial Scholarship:** \$10,000/yr. Available to African-American males. Student must study education, business, law, medicine, architecture, engineering or creative arts. Requires 85 GPA and 1,800 on SATs. Essay also required. Scholarship can be used at any college or university. Application in 7E2. **Deadline: June 15<sup>th</sup>**.

**Union of Jamaican Alumni Associations (USA), Inc., Essay Competition:** Trip for 2 to Jamaica (2), \$500(1), \$300(1), \$200 (1), \$100 (1). Eligibility: Senior of Jamaican parentage. 500 words.
